

Consultation Terms and conditions

No documentation can be evaluated at this time and information and advice is based on what you can tell us – this information cannot be conclusively assessed during a consultation but it is assumed by both parties that verbal and written information is received and delivered based on authenticity.

All fees quoted include applicable taxes but do not cover IRCC application fees, or fees for third services such as Language tests and qualification assessments which should also be considered separate from Representation.

Should it become apparent within the first few minutes that your situation cannot be assisted through a consultation, a full refund of the consultation fee will be offered.

All information and documentation reviewed by the RCIC, will not be divulged to any third party, other than agents and employees, without prior consent, except as demanded by law. The RCIC, and all employees of the RCIC, are also bound by the confidentiality requirements of Article 8.1 and 8.5 of the Code of Professional Ethics.

A consultation will be terminated if any action, verbally or ethically would constitute loss of confidence in either party.

This Agreement is considered terminated upon completion of the consultation.
